Mandated by Federal Law

The Bergen WIB is one of 17 WIBs in New Jersey and one of 550+ WIBs in the United States. All WIBs are mandated by federal law (the Workforce Investment Act) to monitor spending and programs at a One-Stop Career Center that assists in recruiting and training employees and job seekers.

Appointed by County Executive

Bergen WIB Board members are appointed by the County Executive with the advice and consent of the Bergen County Board of Freeholders.
